# SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

## Academic Year 2022-23



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## **Purpose:**

Bennett University offers various scholarships schemes to attract meritorious and diverse category of students in specific programmes as decided by the University.

## **Introduction:**

Award of scholarship will be recommended by the Admission Committee/Fee Committee/Finance Committee and duly approved by the Executive Council.

Seats and Scholarships are filled on a first come first serve basis and are subject to availability. Early application and admission decisions increase admission and scholarship prospects.

The details of the Scholarship offered will be part of the Admission Offer extended to candidates upon selection.

**If the student loses the Admission Scholarship, for any reason like discipline, Backlog or not meeting CGPA criteria, the same will not be restored in subsequent years and the student will be required to pay full fees from the semester that the scholarship is withdrawn.**

**Bennett University offers following categories of Scholarships:**

### **1. ADMISSION SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Bennett University offers Admission Scholarships to the meritorious students for the first year of programs as decided by the University. The decision for the scholarship is based on the candidate's scores in qualifying examinations and other criteria as mentioned in **Annexure A**.

#### **a) Grant of Admission Scholarship (First Year)**

The scholarship will be granted as per the eligibility of the student for admission in the particular program and shall reflect it in his/her Offer Letter. The eligibility and amount of the scholarship duly decided by the Statutory Bodies of the University as per **Annexure A**, which shall be reviewed every year by the Competent Authority.

#### **b) Procedure for Grant of Admission Scholarship:**

This scholarship shall be offered at the time of release of offer letter as per the application submitted by the candidate based on the approved criteria mentioned in **Annexure A**. The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration.

The verified list of all eligible students for Admission Scholarship along with the details of the scholarship offered and the applicable documents shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee comprising of the following members to approve the same:



- (i) Registrar
- (ii) VP Marketing
- (iii) Finance Controller

**c) Withdrawal of Admission Scholarship**

The scholarship shall be withdrawn at any time during a programme, from the date as approved by the Competent Authority, under the following conditions:

- i. The student has failed to produce the documentary evidence of the eligibility on the basis of which his scholarship was decided.
- ii. The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

**2. CONTINUATION OF ADMISSION SCHOLARSHIP**

Continuation of Admission Scholarship in subsequent years is subject to obtaining CGPA as per the table given below or as approved by the Competent Authority for specific program, having no backlog and no discipline case being recorded against the student, which shall be determined after the declaration of the End Semester Results of the Even Semester. Once discontinued the student will not be eligible to restore the admission scholarship.

**a) Procedure for Grant of Scholarship:**

The following procedure will be adopted:

- i. The approved results indicating the attained CGPA, backlog courses details, and UFM cases shall be shared by the Controller of Examination.
- ii. The disciplinary cases details shall be verified by the Registrar from the disciplinary committee minutes
- iii. The compiled list of eligible students prepared by the O/o Registrar, fulfilling the conditions shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee as defined in para 1(b) above.
- iv. Should have earned the minimum credits as specified in the curriculum framework in the respective academic year.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

Once approved by the committee, Registrar office shall notify to students the status of continuation / discontinuation of the scholarship to respective students individually.

**3. ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP**

The Bennett University Academic Scholarships is designed to encourage and reward consistently meritorious performance throughout the duration of the program.

**Academic Scholarship** shall be applicable only for students who were not eligible for admission scholarships during their first year at BU. The key items of such scholarship includes:

- i. The Scholarships will be reviewed and awarded every year. The review cycles will be – at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester for award of Scholarship for 2<sup>nd</sup> year; at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> Semester for award of Scholarship for 3<sup>rd</sup> year; at the end of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester for award of Scholarship for 4<sup>th</sup> year and at the end of 8<sup>th</sup> Semester for award of Scholarship for 5<sup>th</sup> year (currently applicable to integrated LLB students)
- ii. The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.
- iii. Performance Criteria: A student with CGPA of 8 and above on a scale of 10 will be awarded Academic Scholarship of 10% of Tuition Fees as per the review cycles stated in (i) above, provided the student is among the top 10% performers in that program.
- iv. A student who is already on an existing Admission scholarship either by Bennett University or any other scholarship awarded through government or private sources is not eligible for Academic Scholarship.
- v. Should have earned the minimum credits as specified in the curriculum framework in the respective academic year.

**a) Procedure for Grant of Academic Scholarship:**

The following procedure will be adopted:

- i. The approved results indicating the attained CGPA, backlog courses details, and UFM cases shall be shared by the Controller of Examination.
- ii. The disciplinary cases details shall be verified by the Registrar from the disciplinary



- committee minutes
- iii. The compiled list of eligible students prepared by the O/o Registrar, fulfilling the conditions shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee as per composition given below:
- Registrar
  - VP Marketing
  - Finance Controller
  - Dean Academics
  - Dean of Respective Schools

Once approved by the committee, Registry shall notify to the students the status of award to eligible student / discontinuation if previously awarded and not eligible this time to respective students individually.

#### **b) Withdrawal of Academic Scholarship**

The Academic scholarship shall be withdrawn at any time during a programme, from the date as approved by the Competent Authority, under the following conditions:

- i. The student is found to have adopted unfair means/indiscipline case
- ii. The student has any backlogs in his current/previous semesters.

#### **4. SCHOLARSHIP FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD**

In order to promote single girl child education, Bennett University has introduced Single Girl Child scholarship with effect from the Academic Year 2022-23 onwards, with an aim to compensate direct costs of girl education to all levels especially for such girls who happen to be the only girl child in their family.

##### **a) Amount of Scholarship:**

A total of 15% of the tuition fee is applicable for the single girl child in the family. This scholarship is **in addition to the other applicable scholarship**; however, the total scholarship amount must not exceed more than 100% of the tuition fees.

##### **b) Procedure for Grant of Scholarship:**

The single girl child scholarships are filled on the first come first serve basis and are subject to the availability. Early application and admission decision increase admission and scholarship prospects.

The details of the Scholarship offered will be part of the Admission Offer extended to candidates upon selection.

Candidates must enroll for the program by depositing the advance fee by the given due date in the admission offer letter. Should a candidate fail to do so, the candidate shall have no claim over the scholarship. The Scholarship thereafter shall be passed on to the next eligible candidate.

The student interested to avail the Scholarship shall provide a declaration on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of INR 100/- to be filled by the student as per the format provided in **Annexure B**. On





approval from the Competent Authority, the benefit of the scholarship shall be awarded to the student, which shall be mention in the Offer Letter.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration and shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee defined at para 1(b) above.

#### 5. DEFENCE PERSONNEL SCHOLARSHIP

To promote education for the wards of the serving / retired defense services and paramilitary personnel, Bennett University offers additional scholarship on the tuition fee.

##### a) Amount of Scholarship:

A total of 5% of the tuition fee is offered to the ward of Defense Personnel. This scholarship is **in addition to the other applicable scholarship**; however, the total scholarship amount must not exceed more than 100% of the tuition fees.

##### b) Procedure for Grant of Scholarship:

The ward of defense scholarships is offered to the ward of Defense Personnel subject to the availability.

The details of the Scholarship offered will be part of the Admission Offer extended to candidates upon selection.

Candidates must enroll for the program by depositing the advance fee by the given due date in the admission offer letter. Should a candidate fail to do so, the candidate shall have no claim over the scholarship. The Scholarship thereafter shall be passed on to the next eligible candidate.

The eligible student should produce a valid Armed /Paramilitary force's Identity Proof of his/her parent for claiming the scholarship. Following documents in the respective category are mandatorily required to be submitted by the applicant for applying Defence Forces Scholarship at Bennett University:

- Service Certificate to be issued by the respective Commanding Officer of the unit / Head of the Department of respective headquarters, in case of serving personnel.
- Copy of PPO in respect of retired personnel / Certificate from Zila Sainik Board.
- Death Certificate of relevant Defence Forces personnel, if applicable.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration and shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee defined at para 1(b) above.

**6. SIBLING SCHOLARSHIP**

Sibling Scholarship is offered by Bennett University for the duration of overlap of the course of siblings and is applicable to wards of the same parents and not cousins.

**a) Amount of Scholarship**

A scholarship amount of 15% is offered to the eligible students as Sibling Scholarship for the duration of the studies of his/her real brother/sister studying at Bennett University. This scholarship is in addition to the merit scholarship. The total scholarship amount cannot exceed more than 100% of tuition fees.

**b) Procedure for Grant of Scholarship:**

The sibling scholarships are offered subject to the availability. The details of the Scholarship offered will be part of the Admission Offer extended to candidates upon selection.

Candidates must enroll for the program by depositing the advance fee by the given due date in the admission offer letter. Should a candidate fail to do so, the candidate shall have no claim over the scholarship.

The offer releasing team shall confirm that the siblings are from the identical parents by checking the previous records.

The student interested to avail the Scholarship shall provide a declaration on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of INR 100/- to be filled by the student as per the format provided in **Annexure C**. On approval from the Competent Authority, the benefit of the scholarship shall be awarded to the student, which shall be mention in the Offer Letter.

The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration and shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee defined at para 1(b) above.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

**7. ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP**

Alumni Scholarship is offered to the Alumnus of Bennett University who opt to pursue post graduate programs from the University.

**a) Amount of Scholarship**

Scholarship of 15% on tuition fee shall be offered to its Alumni by Bennett University to pursue



any Post Graduate Program in the University. This scholarship is **in addition to the other scholarship**. The total scholarship amount cannot exceed more than 100% of tuition fees.

**b) Procedure for Grant of Scholarship:**

The Alumni Scholarships are offered subject to the availability. The details of the Scholarship offered will be part of the Admission Offer extended to candidates upon selection. Candidates must enroll for the program by depositing the advance fee by the given due date in the admission offer letter. Should a candidate fail to do so, the candidate shall have no claim over the scholarship.

The offer releasing team shall confirm that the Alumni Status of the interested student from Office Record.

The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration and shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee defined at para 1(b) above.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

**8. SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP**

**a) Genesis**

Sports is not only an institutional activity, but it also helps in educating the youth. It educates the youth on the behavioral qualities to help in their social and educational adjustment with the society at large, irrespective of culture, religion, or beliefs. It is not only a method of a recreational growth and development but also helps in the integration of youth with the country's social order.

To bring laurels to the country and for personal professional development in sports, the youth must not only spend their time but also their limited resources to excel. It would be imperative that the country supports their efforts financially so that resources are not a constraint to their education and sports development.

The primary Aim of this Policy is to promote active participation in sports for nurturing talents in various sports disciplines with the following Objectives:

- i. To provide sports scholarships to the medal winners and participants.
- ii. To promote mass participation in sports competitions being organised by the University.
- iii. To motivate the sports persons to achieve higher levels of performance by assisting them financially in relation to education and sports development.

The scheme would be applicable to who secured the medal or participating in International, National University Games (AIU) or State, National, and International Competitions Recognized by Olympic Association of India





**b) Amount of Scholarship:**

Sports Scholarship of 20% to 100% is applicable for candidates who hold state, national or international level participation and position in sports. This scholarship is in addition to the merit scholarship. The total scholarship amount cannot exceed more than 100% of tuition fees.

**c) Eligibility**

**Clause 1.1:** Represented India in Olympic Games, Asian Games, World University/ School Games, World Games, World Championships, World Cups, Commonwealth Games, Asian Meets, Test Matches in Cricket. Commonwealth Championships, Asian Championship. Asia Cup, SAF Games, Davis Games, Wimbledon Championship, US French, Australian Open Tennis Championship, Thomas Cup, Uber Cup, All England Badminton Tournament and International Athletic Permit Meet and any other International Tournament/ Championship, Games and Sports approved by IOA (Indian Olympic Association) and / Govt. of India.

**I. Position/ Participation at the International level competitions/Championships (Clause 1.1) – Scholarships of 100% waiver**

**II. Senior National / National Games / Federation Cup / All India Inter-University**

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Position – Scholarships of 100 % tuition fee waived off.
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 80 % tuition fee waived off.
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 70 % tuition fee waived off
- d. 4<sup>th</sup> Position – Scholarships of 50 % tuition fee waived off
- e. Participation – Scholarship of 40% tuition fee waived off

**III. Junior National / Zonal- wise Inter- University / Ranji Trophy**

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Position – Scholarships of 70 % tuition fee waived off
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 60 % tuition fee waived off
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 50 % tuition fee waived off
- d. 4<sup>th</sup> Position – Scholarships of 40 % tuition fee waived off
- e. Participation – Scholarship of 30% tuition fee waived off

**IV. National Women Championship /School National (SGFI)/ State level**

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Position – Scholarships of 70 % tuition fee waived off
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 60 % tuition fee waived off
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 50 % tuition fee waived off
- d. Participation– Scholarships of 30 % tuition fee waived off

**V. K.V.S National / C.B.S.E National / Navodaya National / Sanik School National / All India Public School National**

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Position – Scholarships of 50 % tuition fee waived off
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 40 % tuition fee waived off
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 30 % tuition fee waived off
- d. Participation – Scholarships of 20% tuition fee waived off

**VI. State Championship (Approved State Games Associations under IOA & Govt of India)**

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Position – Scholarships of 50 % tuition fee waived off
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 40 % tuition fee waived off

- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 30 % tuition fee waived off
- d. Participation – Scholarships of 20 % tuition fee waived off

**VII. C.B.S.E Cluster / K.V.S. / Navodaya / Sainik / Zonal / District**

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Position – Scholarships of 40% tuition fee waived off
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 30% tuition fee waived off
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Position – Scholarships of 20% tuition fee waived off

**d) Procedure for the Sport Scholarship**

1. The Sports Scholarship will be applicable to the District, State, National, International level position /participation.
2. The Scholarship will be applicable to the first-year students (Admission year only).
3. Sports Scholarship of 20% to 100% is applicable for candidates who hold state, national international level participation and position in sports. This scholarship is in addition to the other scholarship received by the student; however, it shall not exceed more than 100% of the tuition fees.
4. Students must submit all the required documents at the time of submission of the application for sports scholarship.
5. The decision for the award of scholarship shall be taken by the sports committee, and no claim would be entertained afterwards.
6. University has the right to change terms and conditions of the sports policy anytime without any prior notice.

**e) Renewal of the Sports Scholarship (from 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Onwards)**

The Sports Committee may propose the renewal policy pertaining to the award of scholarship for the students of second year, who have participated in the sports competitions at various levels that is mentioned above (Refer to the list of games affiliated to I.O.A (Indian Olympic Association)):

1. After first year in the Bennett University, the students can avail Sports Scholarship if he/she achieves the awards/position as per the criteria mentioned above as per his/her eligibility in the sports games/events.
2. To continue to get the scholarship, the students should maintain their academic proficiency (minimum 6.5 CGPA) & without any backlogs. If students cannot reach minimum standard of renewal scholarship policy, the scholarship would be withdrawn for the current academic session.
3. In case of any disciplinary action against the student during his/her stay in the University during the course of the study, they will not be entitled for availing any sports scholarship.
4. Students must apply every year for the continuation of the scholarship on or before the last date as announced every year, failing which scholarship would be withdrawn for that academic year.
5. It shall be the sole discretionary power of the Dean students Affairs & the Sports Officer of the Bennett University to take decisions for recommending the awarding of sports scholarship to students of the respective year of study of the student who has achieved position/participation in various inter-university / national/international level sports competitions



## f) List of Games Eligible for The Scholarship

*The sports scholarship shall be applicable to the following games:*

Athletics, Basketball, Badminton, Chess, Cricket, Football, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Swimming, Snooker, Squash Racket, Table Tennis, Tennis, Weightlifting, Volleyball and Yoga

*Note- Performance of previous three (3) years will be considered for of the scholarship.*

## g) Attendance for Sports Students

The attendance granted to students will be:

- ✓ 10% for inter school matches or other Delhi NCR competitions, and
- ✓ 35% for students who are participating in state, national, or inter-university (AIU) competitions
- ✓ Criteria for students who are participating at the international level can vary as per case-to-case basis depending on the nature of sport. (Approval from the University competent authority will be required)

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration and shall be reviewed by the Sports Committee

## 9. MERIT-CUM-MEANS SCHOLARSHIP

### a) Genesis

The prime objective of Merit-cum-Means Scholarships is to provide financial assistance to deserving students who are meritorious and may require financial assistance to pursue their program at Bennett University. The scholarship will be granted from the first year of the program and will be reviewed each year thereafter.

### b) Applicability

The scholarship shall be applicable to Indian Citizens only and shall cover their studies for all the Undergraduate and Post Graduate Programs offered by the University except MBA-BFSI, MBA-LSCM and Post Graduate Diploma programs.

The scholarship shall be decided on the basis of the merit determined by the fee committee duly approved by the Statutory Bodies of the University and shall be continued for the subsequent years, meeting the CGPA requirement as per the policy.

For availing the Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship, the student will be required to apply in the prescribed form provided as **Annexure D** with all the required valid documents in support which shall be verified by the Scholarship Committee at the time of Registration.

The scholarship will not be admissible to a student who has been granted any other scholarship/grants/concessions/stipends/ex-gratia or monetary awards by the University or any other government or non-government agencies.

**c) Eligibility Criteria and Scholarship**

The students who have secured 70% or more or equivalent for UG Programs and 60% or more or equivalent grade for PG Programs, in their qualifying examination and belonging to EWS Category certified by competent government authority, are eligible for the Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship which shall be 50% of the tuition fees charged for the program in which the applicant is interested. The candidate shall also be eligible for Merit-cum-Means Scholarship for securing ranks/percentile in the entrance examinations applicable for the Program as approved on **Annexure E**. The students shall be required to submit valid EWS Certificate. The award of the scholarship shall be initially for the 1<sup>st</sup> year and shall continue based on his/her performance in the subsequent year. For continuation of the Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship, the student must maintain a minimum CGPA of 07 and above. The Scholarship Committee shall verify and authenticate that all the documents in this regard as mentioned in the policy at the time of Registration.

For the continuation of the Merit-cum-Means Scholarship, the student must apply every year in the prescribed format and submit the latest valid EWS Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.

**d) Withdrawal /Cancellation Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship**

The scholarship shall be withdrawn with immediate effect under the following conditions:

- i. Based on poor academic performance of the student i.e. attaining less than 07
- ii. The student has been found to have adopted unfair means in examinations.
- iii. The student has been debarred from appearing in the examinations.
- iv. The student has a backlog.
- v. If the student has been charged with misconduct, gross indiscipline, use of drugs or narcotics, or indulged in ragging.
- vi. If the student fails to submit valid EWS certificate for the subsequent year.
- vii. The student receives a support/scholarship/concession from any organization within/outside.

Management reserves the right to discontinue the Merit-Cum-Means scholarship in any semester as it deems fit without providing any prior notice. The University is under no obligation to continue to support the students through Merit-cum-Means in case the University decides to discontinue it in future.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

The eligibility conditions shall be verified during document verification stage at the time of Registration and shall be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee defined at para 1(b) above.



## **10. FEE REBATE FOR THE TIMES GROUP EMPLOYEES**

Apart from the above a special privilege shall be given to the children and spouses of Times Group Employees and shall be eligible for a fee rebate of 60% on tuition fee per annum for entire duration of the program with effect from academic year 2022-23.

To avail the said scholarship, a proof of employment of working in the Times Group has to be provided by the ward / spouse of the candidate.

The student should have no adverse disciplinary issues. On occurrence of any proven disciplinary issue/remark, the scholarship will be withdrawn for current semester and subsequent semesters.

### **Other terms and conditions for the Scholarships:**

- a. If a student is eligible for grant of more than one scholarships, the total amount of all scholarships in such cases cannot exceed the total Tuition fees for the year.
- b. The students who are eligible for the scholarship/s as per the norms specified by the University should address their application to the Registrar with relevant documents for consideration.
- c. Scores / Marks / Grades / Ranks as required for award of scholarship should be without any Back / Improvement / Supplementary papers.
- d. If at any stage, it is found that an applicant has concealed, suppressed, distorted any information / facts which would have rendered him / her not eligible for the admission and / or for benefit of fee / scholarship which has been awarded by the University basis initial documentation, then the admission and / or benefit of fee / scholarship will stand cancelled, and all such financial support will be recovered by the University.
- e. In case of any escalation / representation / dispute / discrepancy / clarification, the decision of the Vice Chancellor will be final and binding.
- f. The Management reserves the right to change the scholarship policy as per its discretion.
- g. If there is any further confirmed disciplinary violation, the scholarship will be discontinued permanently. The student will not be eligible for the award of scholarship for subsequent years, if any.

### **DISCLAIMER**


All the scholarship awarded by the university are subjected to approval and abide by the rules and guidelines as described above. The decision of the scholarship selection committee shall be final. All the scholarships are administered through university. No student shall be allowed to avail the scholarship/bursaries/donation etc. independently without formal scholarship




application process and approval by the competent authority of the university. The withdrawal and cessation of the scholarship, without explanation, shall be at the discretion of the university.




