Scholarship, Financial Aid & Important Dates of Admission

At LPU, we offer a diverse range of 150+ undergraduate, graduate, and postgraduate programs tailored to meet your academic aspirations. To streamline the admission process and ensure clarity for our prospective students, we have categorized our programs into two distinct types: **Type I and Type II.**

Type I Programs: Unlocking Opportunities Through LPUNEST*

For programs falling under Type I, admission hinges on qualifying LPUNEST (Lovely Professional University National Entrance and Scholarship Test). LPUNEST serves as a gateway to several programs, including B.Tech, PG Agriculture, PG Sciences, and PG Pharmacy. Upon registration for LPUNEST, candidates have the flexibility to select their preferred examination slot and date. Once successfully passing the exam, candidates proceed to participate in online counseling rounds, scheduled according to the dates outlined on the official LPU website. For select programs such as MBA, Integrated BBA - MBA, specialized B.Tech programs, and Ph.D. programs, the journey continues with interviews. These interviews, conducted by LPU, provide candidates with the opportunity to showcase their skills, ambitions, and suitability for their chosen program. *For certain programmes the National Level Test like CUET, JEE (Main), NCHM JEE, NEET, UCEED, CAT, MAT, GATE, GPAT, CLAT, JAM, NID-DAT, NIFT etc. is also considered for eligibility, subject to fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria and conditions.

Type II Programs: Admission Based on Qualifying Exam

Type II programs at LPU follow a straightforward admission process, relying solely on meeting the eligibility criteria specified in the Prospectus or on our university website. Candidates seeking admission to these programs need only ensure they meet the outlined criteria to secure their spot.

1. Navigating Important Dates for Admission

Admission at LPU unfolds in phases, each representing a distinct period within the admission timeline. Phase 1 commences as early as November, with subsequent phases activated based on seat availability. It's important to note that scholarship opportunities may vary across phases, with reductions occurring as each phase progresses. For Type I programs, candidates must register for LPUNEST and subsequently participate in online counseling rounds as per the specified schedule. The LPUNEST exam, facilitated through online proctored examination, offers the convenience of selecting preferred examination slots and dates according to personal convenience. Upon successfully passing the exam, candidates proceed to participate in the counselling rounds as per the dates specified on LPU's official website. 2.1 Scholarship brackets and Phases:

At Lovely Professional University, scholarship percentages vary across programs, each aligning with specific criteria outlined in a structured manner. These criteria, organized into three brackets - Bracket 1, 2, and 3, serve as indicators of the stringency of requirements. Bracket 1 sets the highest standards, gradually easing conditions in subsequent brackets. Consequently, students meeting the stringent requirements of Bracket 1 receive the highest scholarship, while those falling into Bracket 2 or Bracket 3 are awarded relatively lesser scholarships. This structured approach ensures that every student, irrespective of their circumstances, has the opportunity to access the financial support they deserve.

3.2 Unlocking Opportunities: LPUNEST-Based Scholarships

At Lovely Professional University, we administer our own entrance examination, LPUNEST-2024 (National Entrance and Scholarship Test), serving as the foundation for scholarships across all university programs. The university sets cut-off scores for each scholarship bracket, determining the eligibility criteria for various levels of financial support, as detailed in Table 2. 3.3 Scholarship based on National Level Entrance Test:

- (a) Performance in the following National Level Tests is considered for offering Scholarship in LPU: CUET, JEE (Main), JEE (Main) Paper-II, NCHM JEE, NEET, GATE, GPAT, CAT, MAT, XAT, UCEED, CEED, CLAT, CMAT, NIFT, NID-DAT, NATA, NMAT, JAM.
- **(b)** For every test mentioned above, LPU determines the cut-offs for various scholarship brackets. As an example, the cut-off for different Scholarship brackets on the basis of JEE (Mains) and MAT is given below:

3.4 Scholarship based on Innovation, Startup, Entrepreneurship & Hackathons:

Students are eligible for a scholarship based on their performance in Innovation, Startup, Entrepreneurship & Hackathons. The scholarship amount is determined by the level of achievement. For instance, applicants who have achieved international recognition in the University Startup World Cup will be considered under Scholarship Bracket-1, while those who have received Zonal or State Level Awards will be considered under Scholarship Bracket-3.

3.5 Scholarship on the basis of Performance in Sports, Cultural, R&D and Co-curricular, Social Service and Bravery Awards:

Performance in sports, cultural activities, co-curricular endeavors, social service, research and development, and acts of bravery are recognized and rewarded through different scholarship brackets. For instance, securing top positions in national university championships places students in Scholarship Bracket-1, while excellence in state-level school games qualifies for Scholarship Bracket-3.

3.6 Scholarship/ Fee Benefits for Ph.D.:

Ph.D. applicants may receive scholarships of up to 90% of the program fee, depending on their affiliations and research achievements. Eligible candidates include those from centrally funded research labs, industry professionals, and the teaching fraternity.

3.7 For Toppers of Centre and State Boards:

Students who are among top 20 position holders in the Board Examinations for eligibility Qualification (10th or 10+2 as applicable), may avail scholarship of full programme fee waiver along with the hostel

fee waiver (four-seater air cooled room).

Or Top 20 position holders in board examinations (10th or 10+2) are eligible for a full program fee waiver along with a hostel fee waiver for a four-seater air-cooled room.

4.1 For Defence/ CAPF/ Para-Military Personnel and their Dependents:

With a view to facilitate access of higher education to individuals of the armed forces fraternity, University has provided fee concessions of up to 50% to encourage our dedicated soldiers in the Defence and Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) and their dependents. The services that have been included in the Scholarship Scheme are - Indian Army, Indian Navy, Indian Air Force, Coast Guard, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Border Security force (BSF), Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Railway Protection Force (RPF), National Security Guards (NSG), Special Frontier Force (SFF), Assam Riffles, Border Road Organization, General Reserve Engineer Force (GREF), Defence Research Development Organization (DRDO), Military Engineers Service (MES), and Defence Security Corps (DSC).

4.2 For Orphan Applicants

To facilitate quality education to deserving applicants, LPU offers a special scholarship of Full Programme fee waiver to orphan students who are residents of India. A maximum of 20 applicants will be awarded this scholarship on the basis of first come first serve basis subject to satisfying the laid criteria.

Applicants with Benchmark disability of more than 70% and/or Locomotor disability caused by spinal cord injury can avail the benefit of full programme fee waiver subject to his/her case being approved by the Committee constituted by the University.
